When YHWH brings us into the land which He promised to Avraham and to Yitzchak and to Ya'aqov, then we are to plant our fields for six years. Then on the seventh year we are to let the land rest. Every seventh year we are to let the land rest.

We are to count off seven complete cycles of Shabbat years. Then in the next year it is to be a year of jubilation—the Jubilee year. This is in the fiftieth year.

Then on the tenth day of the seventh month, which is Yom Kippur, we are to sound the ram's horn and declare a year of release of all debts. Those who have come into bondage to a debtor is to go free and return to the land of his ancestors.

Like the land Shabbat every seven years, the fiftieth year is also a year in which the land rests. We are not to work the ground or plant our crops or prune our trees or vines.

Be strong! Be strong! And may we be strengthened in Messiah Yeshua!


