YHWH commands Moshe to take a census of all the tribes of Israel who are males who are twenty years old and older. YHWH commands Moshe not to include the tribe of Levi in this census.

Later YHWH commands Moshe to count all the males of the tribe of Levi who are one month old and older. YHWH then trades all the firstborn of Israel for the Levites. But there is a difference of 273 more firstborn in Israel than there are Levites.

YHWH then commands Moshe that each of those firstborn who were not redeemed by a Levite were to give five shekels as their redemption price.

In this way YHWH redeemed all the firstborn of Israel who became His when He passed through Egypt and killed all the firstborn of Egypt. Because all the firstborn of Israel belonged to Him, He redeemed them with the whole tribe of Levi and they became His to be His priests and ministers before Him, instead of all the firstborn of Israel.

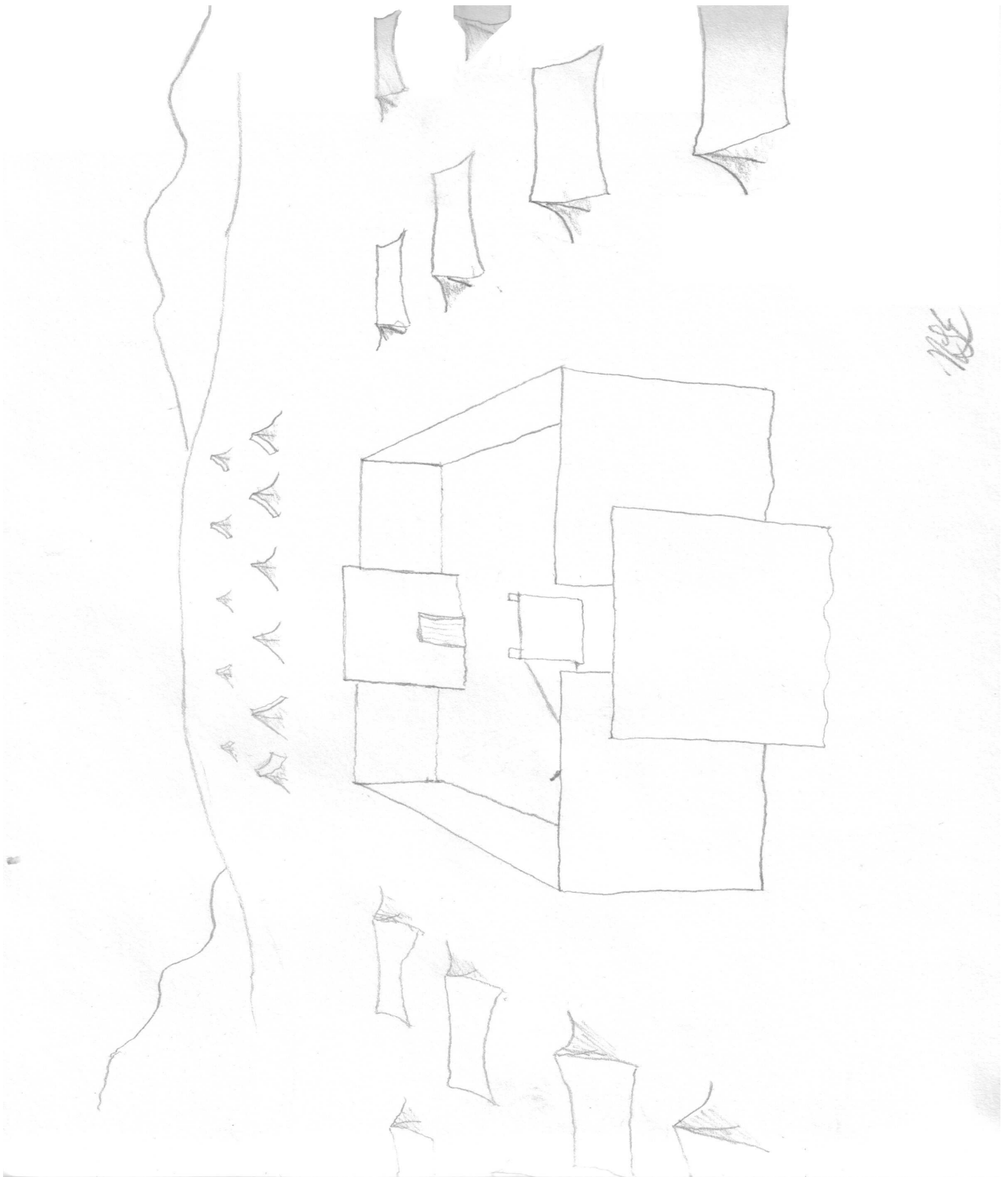
