Pinchas was zealous for YHWH and for His commandments. When Israel began to play the harlot with the gods of the Moabites, YHWH struck Israel with a plague. This plague was killing all those who had bowed down to the gods of the Moabites.


One Israeli man in particular, Zimri and the Midianite woman, Cozbi, were committing lewd acts before YHWH and Pinchas took a spear and pierced them both through and killed them.

The result of this was that this act stopped the plague that was killing the Israeli people.

Because Pinchas was zealous for YHWH, YHWH rewarded him with an eternal covenant of shalom. This covenant proceeds from generation to generation for all the sons of Pinchas who are also zealous for YHWH.

Chapters 28 and 29 teach us of all the sacrifices that YHWH requires each and every day as well as those required on Shabbat and on the first day of the month and on each one of the festivals of YHWH.
