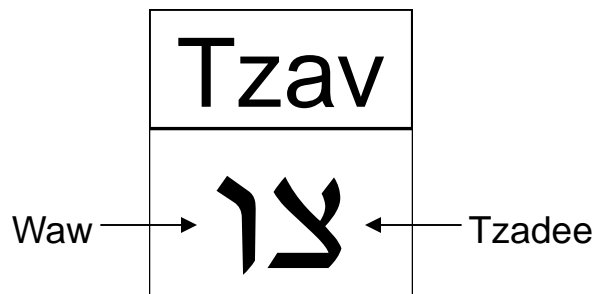
YHWH told Moshe how the sacrifices were to be done and what parts He would get and what parts the Kohanim (priests) would get.

~Vayiqra 6:5~*





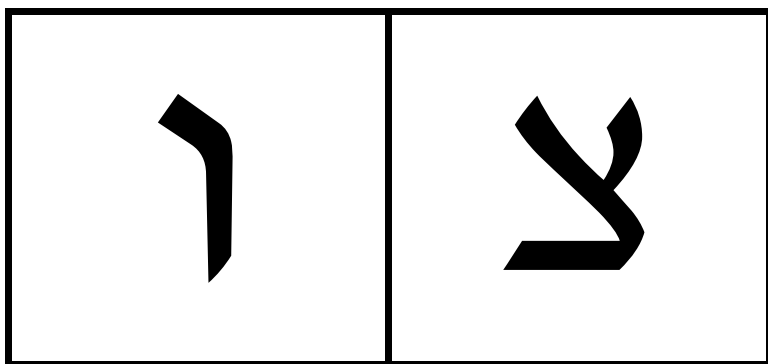

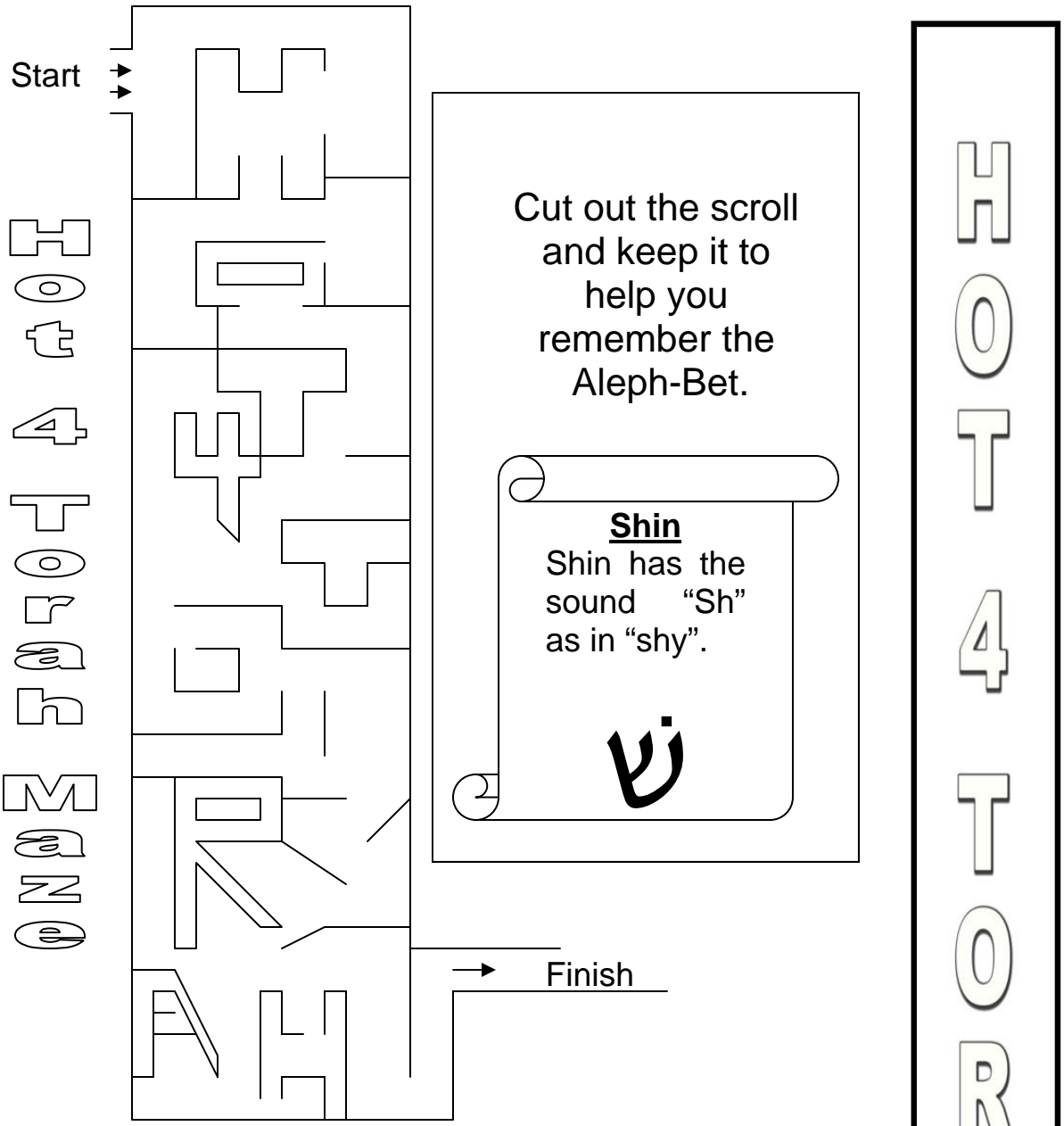

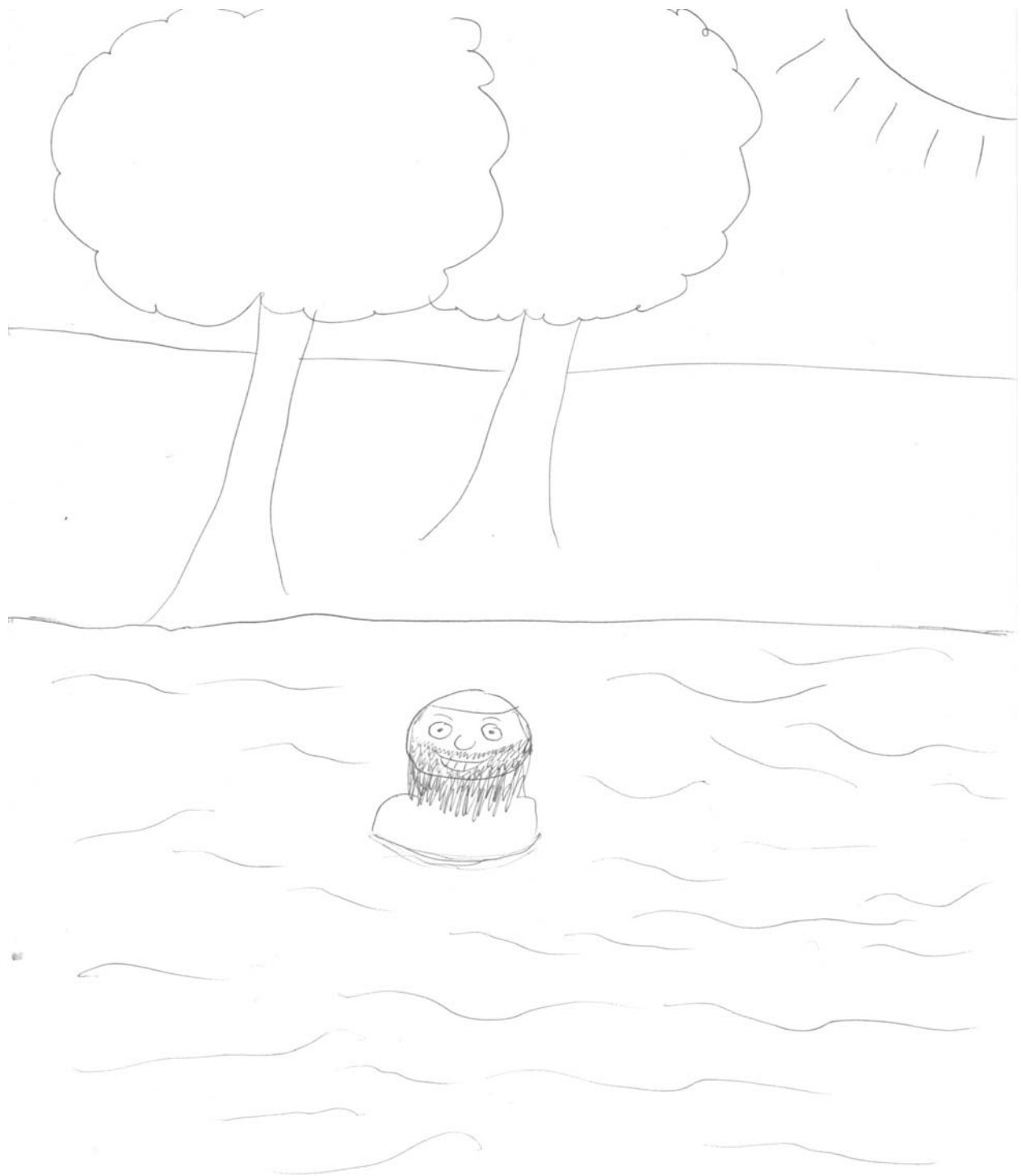
