

The people reached Mount Sinai after three months, and YHWH told Moshe to have them wash themselves and their clothing. For three days they had to keep clean.

On the morning of the third day, there was thunder and lightning. A thick cloud covered the mountain, and there was the sound of a shofar (ram's horn) blasting. The Children of Yisrael were afraid. Moshe brought the people toward the mountain, which was smoking because YHWH had descended on it in the pillar of fire. Smoke ascended from the mountain as if from a great furnace, and the mountain shook. YHWH told the people the following: You shall have no other Elohim before me. You shall not make idols, nor worship them. You shall not bring the name of YHWH your Elohim to naught. Remember the Shabbat, to keep it kodesh (holy). Honor your father and your mother. You shall not kill, commit adultery, steal, or bear false witness against your neighbor. You shall not covet.


The people saw the thunder and flames, and heard the shofar. They told Moshe that *he* could listen to YHWH and tell them what He was saying, because they did not want to hear it. Moshe told them not to be afraid, but they still stood far back.

YHWH then commanded Moshe to make an altar. No tool was to touch it. It was for sacrifices.






